Wellington Context

- **65%** military at Wellington Primary
- **36%** military at the Wellington Academy
 - 45% have attended 4 – 6 schools
 - 15% have attended 7 or more
- Winchester University research last year found that:
 - *Emotional wellbeing, disrupted friendships, increased potential for bullying.*

Wellington Context

Deployment has an inverse impact academically and pastorally creating:

- Increased incidence of emotional and behavioural problems;
- A higher incidence of mental health issues in children and parents;
- Increased incidence of the child as carer.

Wellington Context

- Highest percentage of its total population under the age of 15 years (19.9%) in Wiltshire
- X3 times population growth compared to other Wiltshire community areas
- Carers allowance and income support lone parents is above Wiltshire averages
- X2 rate of 15 – 17 year old pregnancies compared to Wiltshire figures
- Second highest rate of domestic abuse offences of Wiltshire community areas
- 2nd highest alcohol related hospital admission in 2009
- Most local schools are **good**
 - **Feelings of belonging is the lowest in Wiltshire**

Pupils' perceptions of bullying and safety at the Wellington Academy

- **60%** compared to **48%** in average Wiltshire school felt bullying was dealt with effectively (18% did not know – may not have experienced bullying). National figure is around **28%**
- **78%** felt **happy**
- **81%** felt **safe** compared to **73%** in average Wiltshire school
