On Tuesday we opened the door to our new 6th Form cohort. They have some big shoes to fill with the excellent summer results in both A Levels and BTECs. 14% of our A Level students achieved A*-A, 34 % A*-B and 64% A*-C. Our BTECs results were also outstanding with 50% getting Distinction* and 64% getting Distinction or above.

We saw over 50% of our students go to university, with several going to Russell group universities, and the rest joining apprenticeship schemes or full time employment.

Twelve students completed internships in a variety of National & International organisations such as Saatchi and Saatchi, Darwin Group, Daily Telegraph, Mirror, London Evening Standard to name but a few. Over the summer we had ten students working in China with our associated schools. All these exciting opportunities are open to our 6th Formers.
